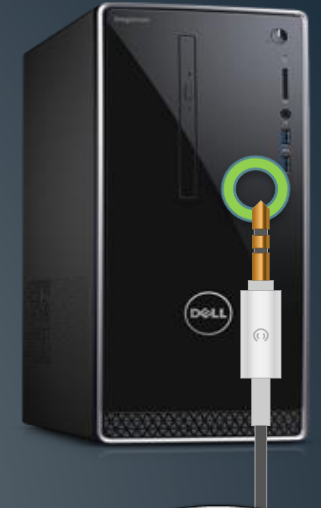


Oxford Online Placement Test (OOPT)

Before the Test

- Turn off your cell phone.
- Plug in your earphones into the green jack hole on the front panel of the desktop.
- Test your earphones.
- Close all the other windows or tabs except the OOPT test site.
- Place your ID on the desk for checking.



Types of Question

1. There are approximately 45 questions.
2. The time limit is 90 minutes.
3. Two parts:

Part One: Use of English – About 30 questions

Task 1: Grammar and Vocabulary

Task 2: Reading

Part Two: Listening – About 15 questions (Earphones required)

A. Conversation

B. Short essay
