

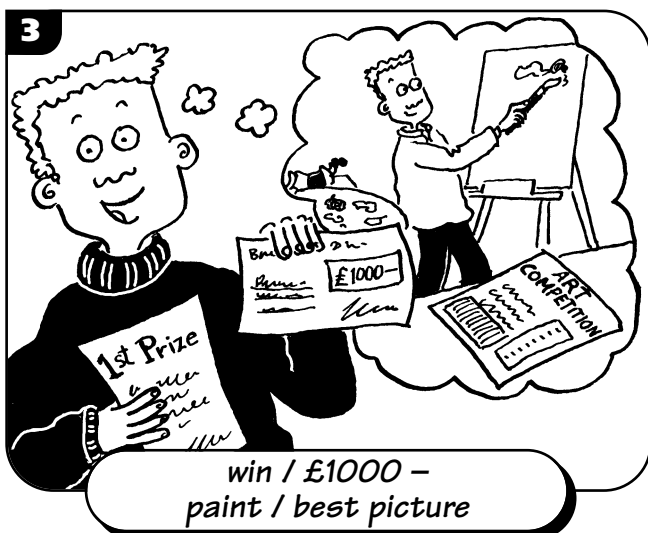
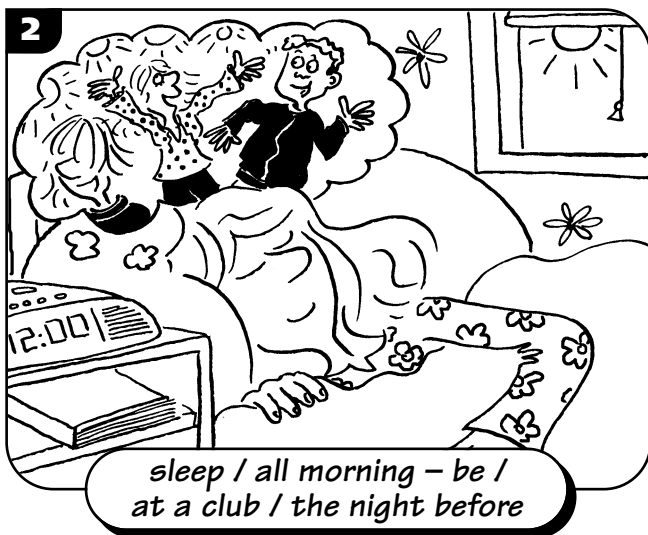
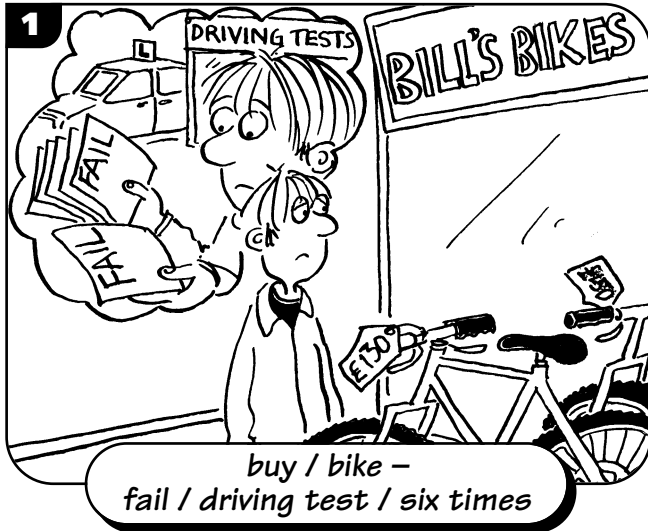


# Why did they do it?
