### COSMETIC SURGERY

According to recent news reports, cosmetic surgery is an increasingly popular birthday gift for teens in the US. In 2000, approximately 25,000 young women and girls had cosmetic surgery. Girls as young as 14 were operated on for bigger breasts or smaller noses or thighs. Is that kind of surgery appropriate at such a young age?

Sommel Seidel of Texas had wanted bigger breasts since she was 15. After she left high school, she thought she'd waited long enough. She didn't need her parents' permission, but she did need financial help from them for the operation. Her father, John, says, "I believed this would make her feel better about herself. People get their babies' ears pierced when they're six months old. Sommer is 18; she 's an adult."

Dana Lieberman of New York, a popular 17-year-old high-school student, didn't like her stomach. It wasn't a question of dieting and getting more exercise. "I'm the kind of person who needs to see results easily," she said. And that's why she decided to have liposuction. Her mother worked extra hours to help pay for the 6,000 surgery. "I just wanted to be supportive of her,"said her mom, "I don't care what she looks like."

Both young women reported that after their surgeries they did indeed feel happy and a lot more confident. That confidence, they say, made the surgery worthwhile. But Dr Tom Geragthy considers such surgery immoral. "You are doing a mature operation on immature people. We all want the perfect body; the new sports car, the wonderful boyfriend or girlfriend, and we want them now. But you can't have them now. And you shouldn't have them now.
