1558-1603




James I had five children, his son was

1603-1625


Charles II had no legitimate children, his brother was

William and Mary had no children. Mary's sister was
Anne
1702-1714



James II was deposed and his daughter was asked to reign instead, jointly with her husband William III.

George II had eight children but his eldest son died before him. His grandson was
George III

George II
1727-1760




Anne had no children who outlived her. Her second cousin was

1910-1936




Victoria had nine children, her son was
