En 1838, la collection abritée à Pall Mall fût transférée ici à **Trafalgar Square**. Aujourd'hui, elle abrite plus de 2,300 œuvres.



In 1918, \_\_\_\_\_ promised a group of paintings to the French nation as a '**monument to peace**'. They are called the '**Water-Lilies**', they continue to captivate visitors almost a century later.

They water-lily series was started during the **First World War**, a time of tragedy for .....

the loss(*la perte*) of his wife and son, his declining eyesight, (*baisse de sa vue*) and the international conflict.
