The Price of Football

My name is Ashley Parkes. Nine months ago, I started playing football for my school. The team coach told us to go and see as many football matches as possible to help us play better. I decided to go and see one of the big, famous football clubs play a match. My mum and dad wanted to come with me, and they agreed to pay for the tickets. When Mum asked me how much football tickets were, I couldn't answer, so I went online to find out. What a nasty surprise! The cheapest tickets for the next match were £41 (\$65, €44) – £123 for the three of us. There weren't any discounts for children or students. And a ticket for the whole football year cost £999 per person!



I told Mum the match ticket price, and she said it was too much. Then Dad said, 'Why don't we go and watch our town club on Saturday? It's a small club, but they're playing well at the moment and I don't think it'll cost £41 each to see them!' On their website, I found some tickets for the match. They cost £15 for adults with a seat, or £13 standing up, but under-16s only pay £6 with or without a seat. What a difference! We went to the match and enjoyed it so much that we joined the club and now we go to every game.

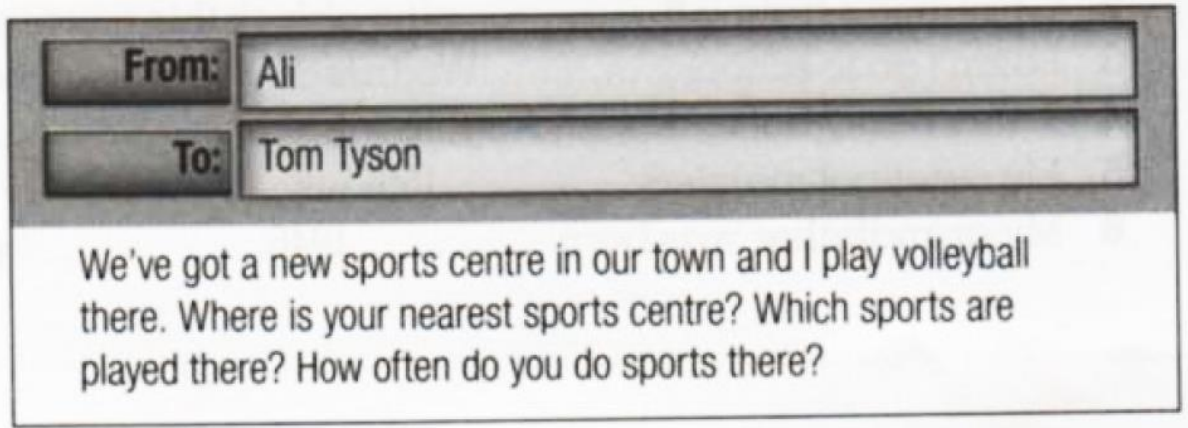
