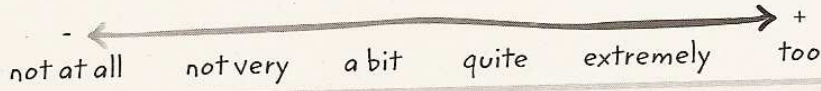

*Au présent simple, il faut ajouter un « S » à la 3ème personne du singulier (He, she, It) soit au verbe (forme affirmative), soit à do qui devient **does** (formes négative et interrogative).*

✚ On emploie le présent en be + ing pour :

- Faire un commentaire sur ce qui est en train de se dérouler sous nos yeux.

Ce qui est le plus important : Celui qui parle (= énonciateur) s'intéresse à l'action dans son déroulement. Il montre du doigt ce qui est en train de se passer.
