

## La prononciation du -ed du prétérit

Le -ed du prétérit se prononce :

- \* soit [d] après les sons [d] ou [t] : need » needed want » wanted
- \* soit [t] après les sons [s] : pass » passed  
[p] : stop » stopped  
[k] : look » looked  
[f] : cough » coughed  
[ks] : fax » faxed  
[ʃ] : brush » brushed  
[tʃ] : watch » watched



\* Dans tous les autres cas, il se prononce [d] : play » played open » opened
