	There are a lot of mountains. The altitude is high so it's very cold. There is a big forest. There is less space to build so they build on slopes (on cliffs). There is snow	This is a <b>high mountain</b> .
	This is a desert : there is no water, no rain so there is no vegetation. This place is very hot. This is an <b>arid</b> climate (=very dry)	This is a <b>hot desert</b>
	This is a very cold place so there is no vegetation. There is ice everywhere, on the sea and on the mountains. There is no rain of snow.	This is a <b>cold desert</b>
	There are big trees everywhere. There are dangerous animals. The forest is very dense so it's dark. People have to cut the trees to settle. The climate is hot and rainy.	This is a <b>tropical rainforest</b>
	This is an island. There is a volcano in the middle of the island, so there is almost no place to settle. The continents are very far. It is an isolated place.	This is a <b>isolated place</b>

### Conclusion :

Sparsely populated places (low population density) often have **extreme** environments. When you live there, you must **adapt to** extreme living conditions.
