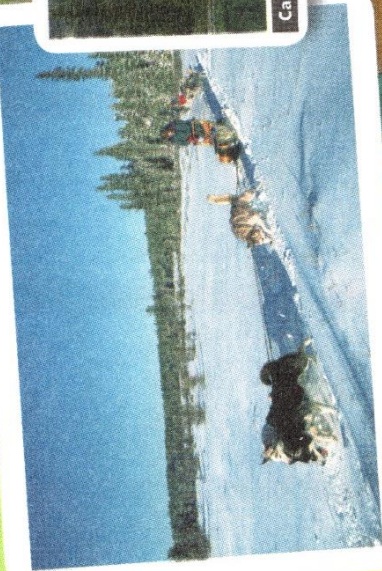


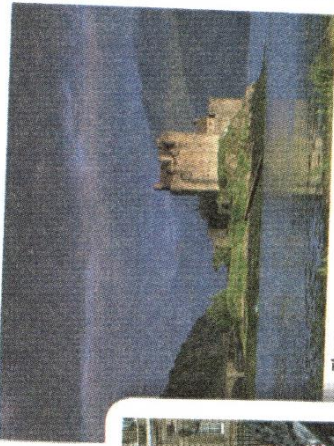
Where is English spoken?

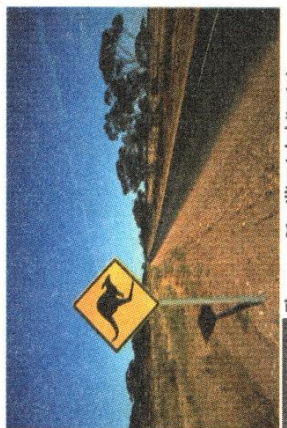
Most common languages in the world:

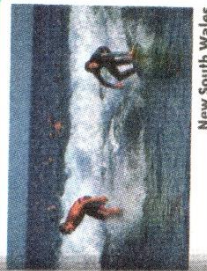


New Zealand There are 4 million people in New Zealand and 40 million sheep.

English as official or semi-official language



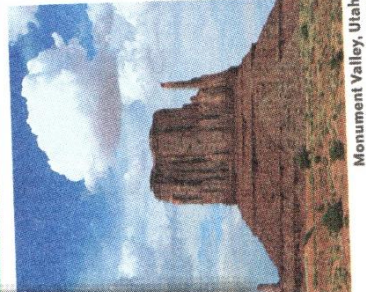
Australia There are 20 million inhabitants in Australia and 40 million kangaroos.
