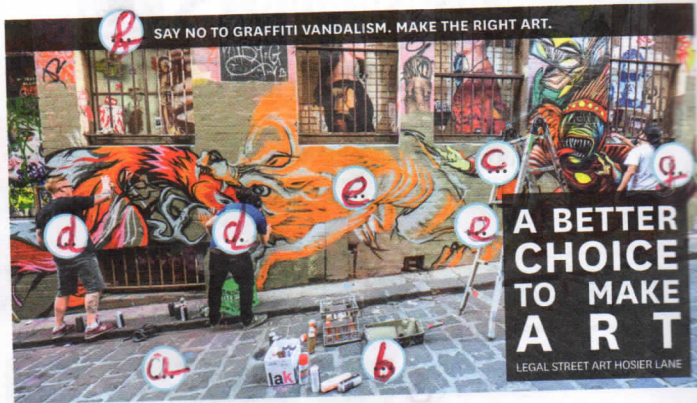


### 3 Legal graffiti
