2) What is the name of the famous Irish celebration? The name of the famous Irish celebration is Saint Patrick’s day.

3) When is it celebrated? It is celebrated on March 17th.

4) What do people do on that day? People wear green clothes (= they dress in green), they decorate their town (= city) and their monuments in green, they drink green beer and they organize a parade.

6) What did people do in the 19th century because of the potato famine?

Because of the potato famine in the 19th century, a lot of Irish people emigrated to the United States, to Australia or to England. They didn’t want to die of hunger = to starve (= mourir de faim) that’s why they left Ireland(= c’est pourquoi, ils quittèrent l’Irlande).

7) What famous places can you visit or see in Ireland?

In Northern Ireland, I can visit Titanic Belfast museum and the Giant’s Causeway.

In the Republic of Ireland, I can visit Trinity College, Samuel Beckett Bridge in Dublin and also Kilkenny castle, Connacht lighthouse and Neolithic stone circles.
